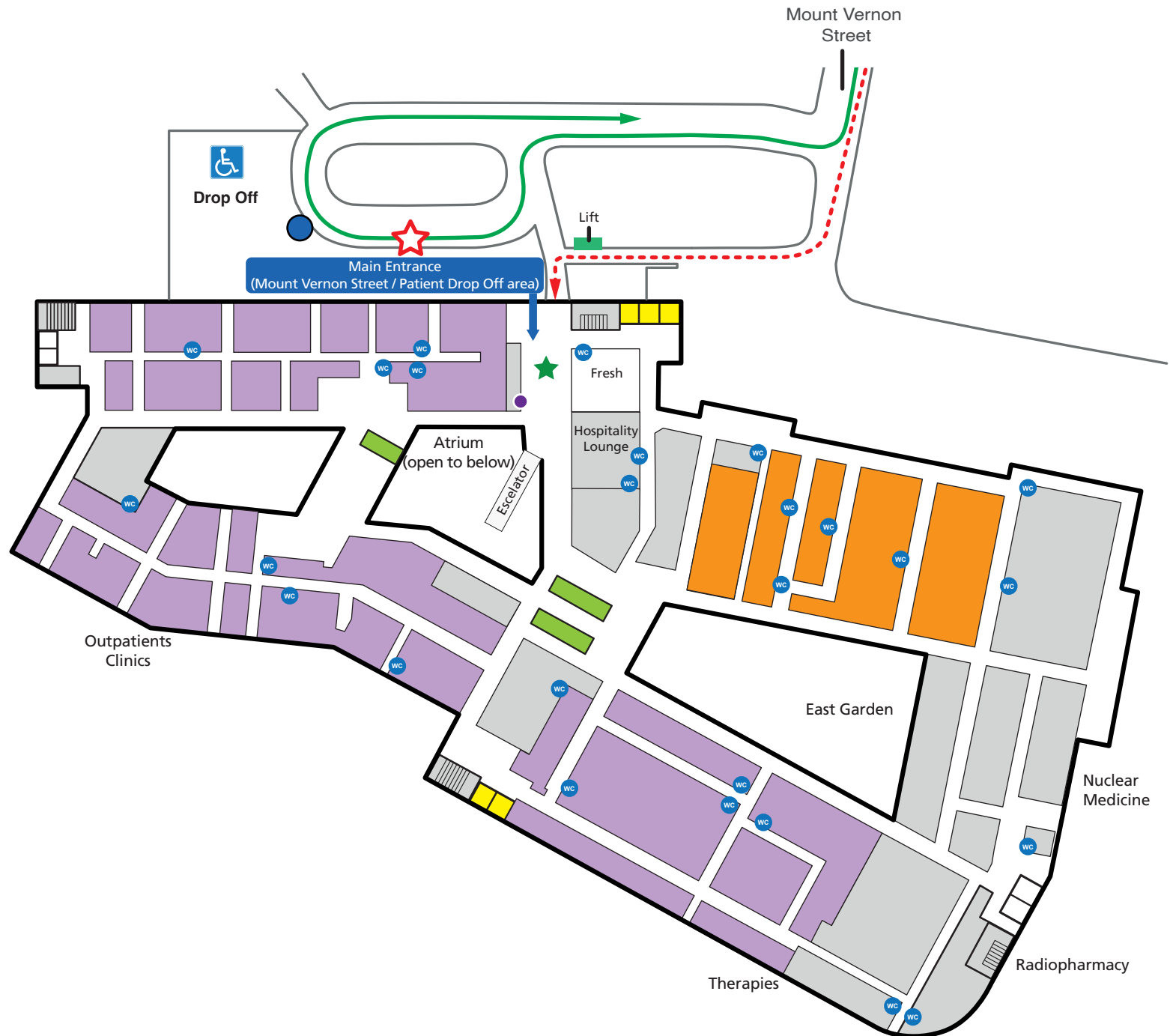

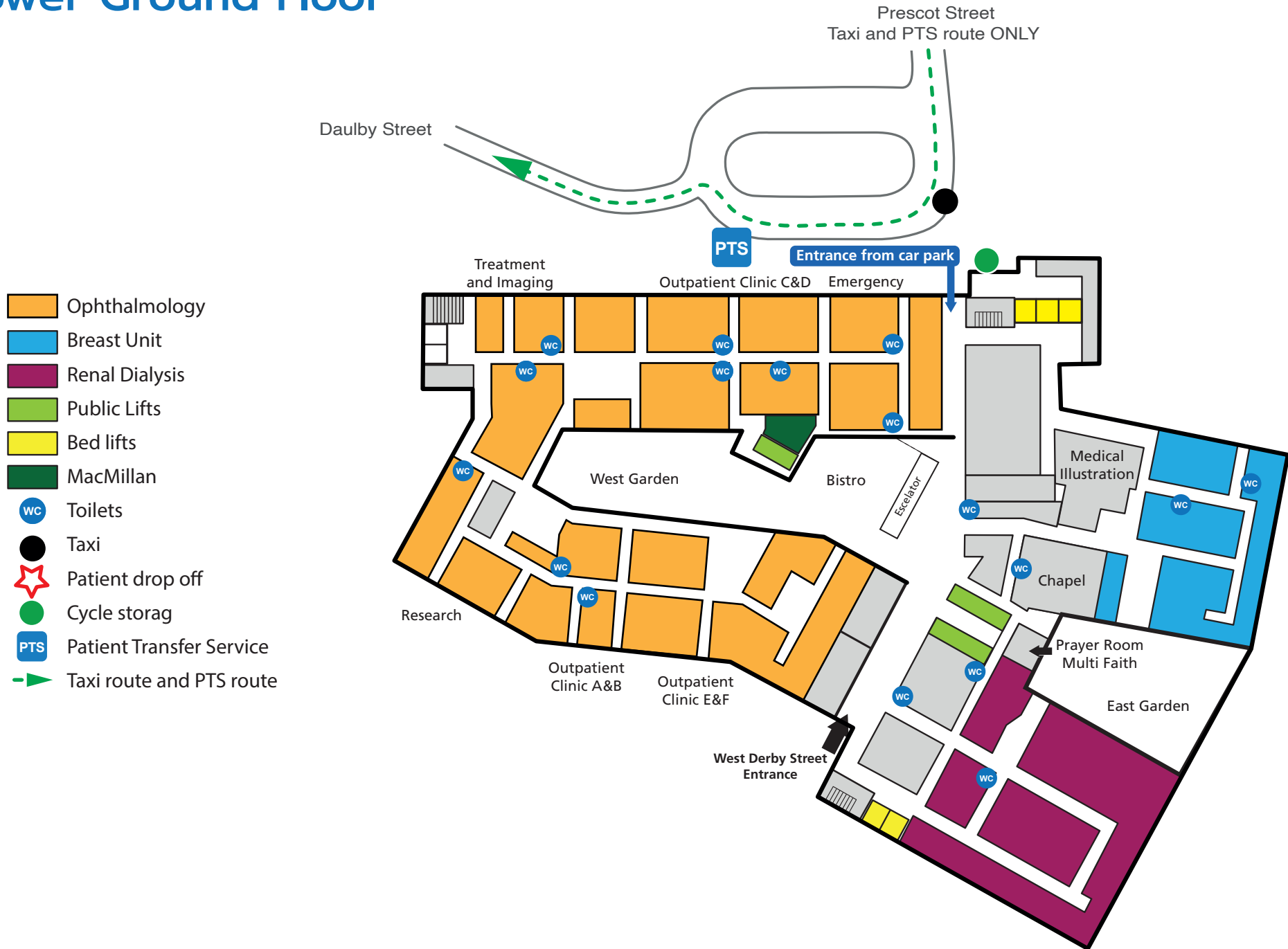

Travel Information

The new Royal Liverpool University Hospital is connected to local active travel routes and serviced by a range of public transport options.



By foot

The new Royal is less than a mile on foot from Lime Street Station, Central Station and Queens Square bus station, and is accessible via Prescot Street and West Derby Street.



Cycle

There are cycle routes nearby.



Bus

There are a variety of bus services which operate from the surrounding areas and drop off at the hospital or within walking distance. To find information about times and services, please contact the Merseytravel Traveline on 0871 200 2233 or visit www.merseytravel.co.uk



Train

The hospital is about one mile from Lime Street Station, which serves the main city line, regional and national rail networks. Taxis are readily available from the station details of bus services linking local train stations and the hospital can be found at www.merseytravel.co.uk



Coach

The National Express Coach Station is located in the Liverpool One bus station, approximately 1.5 miles from the hospital. Several local bus routes can be picked up at the bus station to complete the journey to the new Royal.



Car

The hospital is well signposted throughout the city and well connected to regional highway network. A drop off point is situated at the front of the hospital on Mount Vernon Street (Sat Nav L7 8YE) and parking is available in the Q-Park multi-storey car park accessible via Epworth Street (Sat Nav L6 1LY).

Accessible car parking is provided at the Q-Park multi-storey.

There are 20 disabled spaces, 17 located on the first floor, 2 on the second floor and 1 on the ground floor. Staff are available to provide assistance to patients and visitors as required.

Accessible spaces are available on the entry level and are well marked and signposted. Staff are available to provide assistance to patients and visitors as required.

Q-Park has been assessed by Liverpool City Council Disability Discrimination Act officials to ensure it is DDA compliant.

The car park has a designated pick up zone and improved entrance and exit areas including better crossing points outside the car park.

There is a height restriction of 2.1 metres at Q-Park so if you have a vehicle above this height please contact the Trust's Security Team on 0151 706 2228 to make alternative arrangements.
